Entry Fee:

Each application must be accompanied by 2 checks. One for \$25 (non-refundable jury fee) and one for \$150 for the exhibition space. The \$150 check will be returned if the artist is not accepted.

Slides:

The quality of your slides will help determine your acceptance. Photos may be submitted on slides or CD. Please take the time to make and enter only slides that best show the excellence of your work. The slides will be juried by a panel of qualified persons.

1. April 15th is the deadline for entry forms with appropriate slides.
2. Submit four 2"x2" slides (35mm) or four photos on a CD:
 - a. Showing your display & tent
 - b. Showing your type of work
 - c. Showing your work at its finest

3. Please mark the CD/slides with your name and mark which side is the front.
4. Please enclose self-addressed stamped envelope for the return of your photo submission. Acceptance letters will go out separately by May 15, 2012.

Spaces:

Selected artists will be assigned a 10'x10' space. Only professional white tents will be allowed. Electrical hook-ups are minimal. Low noise generators are acceptable. Sunset is around 8:20 p.m., so artists should not require lighting for the show. Spaces will be numbered and assigned before the show. Locations of artists will be determined by the Committee based solely on media mix. Please do not ask for a special location.

Artists:

Artists must be present to display their own work; proxy exhibitors are not permitted. The work of only one artist may be displayed in each assigned space. Two person teams producing a single product may qualify as a single exhibitor. Artists are responsible for their own tents, tables, coolers and chairs. Volunteers will be on hand to help you, to man your tent for short periods & to help with lunch.

Set-Up Hours:

You may set up your tents any time between **10am and 6pm on Tuesday, June 19 only.**

Show Hours:

**Wednesday, June 20, 10am-6pm
Thursday, June 21, 10am-5pm**

No Rain Dates or Refunds: The show goes on, rain or shine, so artists should be prepared for the weather.

Sales:

Over 100,000 visitors will be on the Outer Banks of North Carolina and they will be invited to see & buy your work. Small is good... most families will be traveling by car with limited space so don't hesitate to bring small works too! **NC 7.75% Sales Tax** is the responsibility of each individual artist.

Judging:

Starts at **11am Tuesday**

Awards Dinner:

Starts at **6pm Wednesday. Best in Show \$1000**

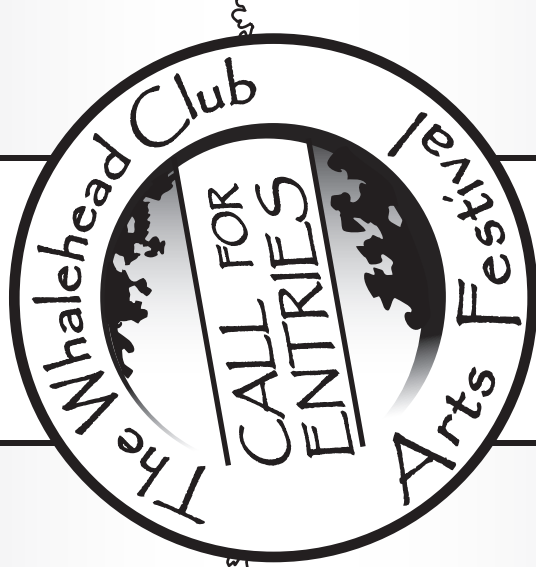
Work that is not appropriate for a family show cannot be displayed.
